PARTICIPATION POLICIES

Registration

You may register for classes with either Fort Caspar Museum at (307) 235-8462 or with the National Historic Trails Interpretive Center at (307) 261-7780. All classes are FREE.

Age Guidelines:

The History Club/ Hands-^{on} curriculum is geared for children in 2nd through 5th grade. Older and younger children are welcome to attend, but younger children must be accompanied by a parent/ guardian.

Hours of Operation and Location

The History/ Hands-^{on} program hours are 10:00am to 11:30am, on the SECOND Saturday of each month. Please do not drop your child off prior to 10 minutes before the start of their class. **PLEASE NOTE: Location of classes will alternate MONTHLY** between the National Historic Trails Interpretive Center and Fort Caspar Museum.

Pick-up and Drop-off Procedures:

Children need to arrive between 9:50-10:00am. Children arriving after 10:15 will be considered late and may not be admitted to class, depending on the number of students and supplies needed. Sign-in and sign-out by a designated parent/guardian is strongly encouraged.

Late Pick-Up:

Parents/ guardians who pick-up their children later than 11:45 will be considered late. Repeated late pick-ups may result in the removal of the student from further classes.

Personal Belongings:

Children should not bring toys, mobile phones, electronic devices, jewelry, money, or any possessions of value with them to any of the History Club/ Hands-^{on} classes. Children will be responsible for their belongings.

Sunscreen/ Insect Repellent:

Some, or a portion, of our classes are conducted outdoors. If you are concerned about sunburn or insects, please apply sunscreen and/ or insect repellent to your child, prior to the start of each class. Children may bring sunscreen and/ or insect repellent, but must be able to reapply it themselves with staff supervision. Spray or mist sunscreen and insect repellent are recommended. Sunscreen and/ or insect repellent must be labeled with the child's name. Children may not share these items with others.

Behavior Management/ Discipline:

Staff will create a fun and safe environment for students taking part in the program. Praise and positive reinforcement are used as effective methods of behavior management. Students who do not respond to these methods or who are destructive to others or property will be dealt with in a professional, positive, and timely manner to correct the behavior. In the event a student's behavior is a repeated behavior and cannot be corrected by Staff with a verbal warning or other form of behavior modification, the parent/ guardian will be informed.

Repeated, behavior problems may result in the student's dismissal from the program.
